There are many different types of traditional (传统的) operas in China. Beijing Opera (Peking Opera) is the most famous one.

Beijing Opera is a comprehensive (综合的) performing art. It combines $^{(结合)}$ singing, dialogue, monologue $^{(独白)}$, martial arts $^{(武术)}$, acrobatics ^(杂技) and mime ^(哑剧) together.

There are four types of main roles in Beijing Opera. They are



Sheng



Dan



Jing



Chou (male (男性的) role) (female (女性的) role) (painted-face male role) (comedic (喜剧的) male role)

Roles are classified $^{()\pm)}$ by the age and personality $^{()\pm A)}$ of the characters.



Facial makeup (脸谱) is very important in Beijing Opera. It shows the role's personality by using different colors. The basic colors used in **modern** ^(现代的) Beijing Opera painted faces are red, purple, black, white, blue, green, yellow, pink, gray, gold, and silver.





In Beijing Opera, actors must follow many acting rules on stage, such as how to sit down, take a step (迈步), open a door, ride a horse, row (划) a boat, and so on.
